

Job Opening at Gale's Equine Facility

We are looking for dependable team members for horse handling, horse feeding, and stall cleaning. Main hours for work will include 6 to 7 hours (between noon and 7PM) on Saturday and Sundays. Weekday work may also be available for up to 30 hours per week. Starting pay will depend on your existing experience, somewhere between \$15 and \$20/hour with future increases based on performance.

We have machinery that cuts down the time to thoroughly clean the stalls. It's pretty awesome. We often use a spray disinfection and odor control spray in each stall before reapplying the pellet bedding to the stall. Stall cleaners also maintain the stalls' water and feed buckets. It's not difficult, but care and desire to do a good job is required. Candidates must be able to do heavy lifting (such as hay bales and full wheelbarrows) and remain calm around horses. Horses are led out to and brought in from assigned exercise areas, daily. So, candidates must be able to learn how to do this and follow our safety protocol.

Feedings of the horses are done three times per day, and the existing team can teach the new members how we do our feeding programs....as well as learning how to groom and assist the instructor during her lessons. More hours are available during the week if the candidate would like more hours to work. Horse Farms operate seven days per week, and we work every holiday and snow day throughout the year so expect that this will happen. Applicants must have current driver's license and be eligible to work in the United States. If you are interested in applying for the job, applications are available at the stable and here:
